

INVITATION FOR THE EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Fiji Roads Authority is establishing an Expression of interest for Consultants and Contractors for Future Work Opportunities.

Fiji Roads Authority ('FRA') invites Expression of Interest from International and National Infrastructure Development Consultants and Contractors. FRA is a Government Statutory Body responsible for the effective management and building of Roads, Bridges and Jetties for the country. FRA manages a network of approximately 7,500 kilometres of sealed and unsealed roads, and approximately 1200 bridges and 47 jetties.

FRA is funded by the Fijian Government. The budget allocation for 2016 is \$635 Million Dollars (FJD). The components of the funding include local grant funds, Asian Development Bank and World Bank multi-year loan programs as well as various other loan programs.

The momentum to renew and expand the road network will continue into the future in line with Government's policy direction and vision to build a better Fiji for all Fijians.

FRA outsources professional services and all construction activities using competitive tendering procurement to engage suppliers. This includes activities related to:

- network management and maintenance;
- renewals of roads, bridges and jetties; and
- Capital investment in new road related assets.

FRA calls for Expression of Interest ('**EOIs**') from experienced Consultancy and Contracting Firms to provide submissions for the following activities:

1. Consultancy services for scoping, investigation, design and construction monitoring of road, bridge and jetty projects including:
 - Structural Engineers;
 - Civil Engineers (hydrology, roads, etc.);
 - Bridge Engineers;
 - Quantity Surveyors;
 - Traffic Engineers; and
 - Geotechnical Engineers.
2. Construction and maintenance of roads, bridges, jetties and associated infrastructure across urban and rural areas of Fiji.
3. Transportation planning and asset management.

Prospective proposers are expected to provide the following information:

- (i) Company profile showing core business experience, organisational structure, accreditations, company structure, incorporation, parent company details, and branch offices in Fiji or in the Pacific;
- (ii) Relevant activity areas of interest;
- (iii) Relevant experience and brief details of projects undertaken in the past 10 years;
- (iv) CV's of Key Personnel within the organisation (do not provide CVs of Consultants or Sub-contractors not employed by your organisation); and
- (v) Any other relevant information.

EOIs should not exceed more than 35 pages. EOIs close on **Monday 21st March 2016 at 4.00pm**. All submissions are to be made by either hand delivery or via www.tenderlink.com/fijiroads
